Rationale: As a year group, our aim is to prove that we are the very best we can be and we are ready to take on the challenges of Year 6, being the role-models for the rest of the school. Lead Subject: PDL

We will consider the rights and responsibilities of being in Year 6 and how it is important to lead by example when being the eldest in the school. Seeing things from other people's point of view will be a prominent theme for exploration during this first week back.



Lead Subject: English

We will begin by looking at an example of an autobiography and everything that needs to be included to really entertain our reader – it can't just be facts about us; we want our readers to really feel like they know us! We will be creating lists, using a colon so that we can get as much information across in one go. We are really hoping to get a sense of who the children are from these informative pieces of writing.

Lead Subject: D.T

In Design Technology the children will be designing and making a fabric bookmark that reflects their individuality. They will need to reinforce it to make it durable/strong and then sew/applique designs and textile motifs onto their bookmark before finally sewing it all together.
