



Title: All About Me

YEAR: 2026 TERM: Autumn 1
YEAR GROUP: 3

Rationale: This project will provide children with the opportunity to explore poetry that celebrates themselves and their identity. Through reading and discussing a range of poems about ourselves and the people who are important to us, children will develop their understanding of how poets use language to express thoughts, feelings and experiences.

Children will respond creatively to poetry through discussion, art, drama and exploration of language. They will be encouraged to share their own ideas, make personal connections and develop confidence in expressing themselves. Alongside this, they will develop their understanding of the relationships they have and the part they play.

Lead Subject: PDL

During the 'Me in Year 3' project, the children will be exploring their own identity and those of their peers. We will consider how we all belong to our new classes and new year group. Our similarities and differences will be celebrated! We will be revisiting the Park Gate Way and the school values. As part of our project, we will consider how we build relationships with those special people around us.

Lead Subject: English

In English, we will be reading and writing poems about ourselves using adventurous vocabulary whilst building upon our sentence skills from Year 2. We will read and recite lots of different poems and think about what the poet's intention was and why they wrote the poems in that style.

Lead Subject: Art

We will be sculpting using clay to create our face. We will be learning how to join clay and use different equipment to create shapes and texture.



School Values: Trust

We will be looking at all the school values. We want to encourage the children to always do their best and to aim high! We will discuss neat presentation, hard work and aiming high to fulfil their goals.

Applied Subject: Computing

Children will be revising the basics of how to log in and how to save work in the correct place. They will also be revisiting the importance of internet safety and making posters to advise others on how to stay safe online.

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Maths:

In maths, we will be consolidating our Year 2 learning about place value. We will be revising the value of each digit in a two-digit number. We will look at the concept of 'one hundred' and use this when solving problems.

Home learning:

Continue to record reads at home in your reading record book. We will start counting your reads from 11th September towards your Reading Star badges. Don't forget to return your brown bag with your 5 items all about you.

Outcome: We look forward to inviting parents and carers into school to see our classrooms and work produced in this project on Thursday 17th September 3-4pm.
